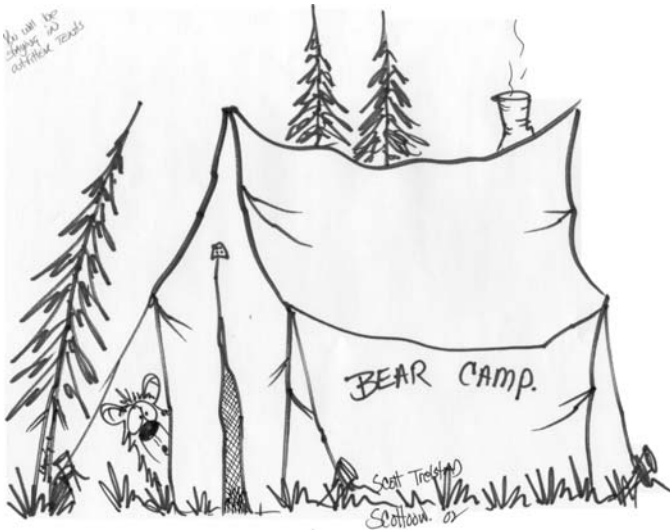


# Adventure of a Lifetime

Remember, a successful hunt is one where the experience is appreciated and enjoyed in its entirety and we will do our best to ensure that opportunity.

As the hunter, you will have a lot of important work to do... You will be taught respect and appreciation for the outdoors. An honourable regard for fair-chase rules will be first and foremost. We will be encouraging the proper use of rifle or archery equipment so that kills will be done as humanely as possible. Wildlife habitat, clothing and equipment, regulations, ethics and responsibility, field techniques, and proper hide preparation will all be a part of your education.

## Join us for a Spring Bear Adventure!

This is a fully guided, 3-day hunt.

All expenses are covered (except hunting license), including transportation to and from Edmonton to the camp.

The hunting camp is located approximately 2 hours northwest of Edmonton.



The hunt dates are:

May 6-8, 2010

Depart Edmonton - (Early morning on May 6th)

Arrive in Camp and begin hunting

Depart from Camp and Return to Edmonton – (Sunday, May 9<sup>th</sup> in the morning)

## **HOW CAN I GO?**

If you are between the ages of 12 and 17 years old, you are eligible to participate in this exciting opportunity! It's easy! Simply write a brief essay (printed or typed), double-spaced and containing no more than 750 words.

Choose one of the following topics:

- (a) **Why I Need To Take An Adult Hunting!** Tell us if you're planning to take your Mom or Dad, Aunt or Uncle, School Teacher or friend. You'll both get to hunt; we just want to know why this hunt would be so special with this person. (The winning youth entry will receive a bear hunt for 1 youth & an adult of their choice).

- (b) **Why I love to hunt?**

What is it about hunting that makes you love it so much? How can you get up at the crack of dawn to go hunting every day and never complain? How can you sit for hours, being cold and wet and tired and have only a big smile to show for your efforts? (A maximum of two winning youth entries will be selected from this category.)

Entrants must be Alberta residents, have successfully completed the Conservation and Hunter Education Training Program and purchase the necessary hunting license. Either rifle or bow & arrow may be used for this hunt. Entries must include full name, mailing address, telephone number, e-mail (if available), date of birth and the date of Hunter Education Certification. All entrants will receive a special 2010 Hunting For Tomorrow and Alberta Hunter Education Instructors' Association Youth Hunter package. A panel including representatives from the Alberta Hunter Education Instructors' Association and Hunting For Tomorrow will judge the entry submissions. Essays will be evaluated against submissions within their respective age category. Contest winners will be announced before April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
