

Participants will learn how to reload their own metallic rifle cartridges during this hands-on first session.

The workshop is open to all A.H.E.I.A. instructors, volunteers and the general public 18 years of age and older. Space is limited.

The *2017 Reloading Clinic – Metallic Rifle* will provide the participants with the sound basics when it comes to reloading.

Topics covered;

- Basic reloading precautions
- Equipment – reloading press options and what to choose
- Case preparation and care
- Choosing your powder and measuring equipment
- Primers and priming tools
- Which bullet is best for me
- Setting up your loading bench
- Loading manuals and record keeping
- Maintenance
- Selecting which dies to use
- Plus much more

Registered participants will be contacted prior to attending the Clinic to discuss development of their own personal 'load'. You will be responsible for providing your own brass cases, smokeless powder, primers and bullets. All other equipment will be provided. We will even clean your brass cases for you prior to the Clinic should you desire it.
